## Dear Counsel:

I find it peculiar, to put it most mildly, that I am receiving motions to reargue the decision which I gave to the parties in my letter of December 19th. The case which I cited Appriva Shareholder Litigation Co., LLC v. eV3, Inc., involved the same circumstances as those raised by those seeking reargument of that December 19th letter. There are additional documents offered in the motion to dismiss all of which the parties had as was the case in Appriva. The Appriva involved decisions by me and Judge Scott on motions to dismiss with those papers, and neither "losing" party in our opinions raised the motion to dismiss/summary judgment issue before us but did it for the first time before the Supreme Court. In my view, Appriva has substantially altered how we can proceed in this Court on motions to dismiss.

Since there is not unanimity regarding my ability to decide this case on the submissions to date, the motion to dismiss is **DENIED WITHOUT PREJUDICE**. The
