## ORDER

This 8th day of January 2008, it appears to the Court that:

- (1) On December 13, 2007, the petitioner, Dennis A. Elliott, filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus in this Court. On that same date, the Clerk of the Court issued a notice to Elliott to show cause why his petition should not be dismissed for this Court's lack of original jurisdiction to issue a writ of habeas corpus.<sup>1</sup>
- (2) On December 19, 2007, Elliott filed his response to the notice to show cause. Elliott did not address the jurisdictional issue in his response.
- (3) The Delaware Constitution does not confer original jurisdiction upon this Court to hear petitions for writs of habeas corpus.<sup>2</sup> Elliott's petition for a writ of habeas corpus must, therefore, be dismissed.
