KUHN, J.

Defendants-appellants, Kenneth Jackson and the Terrebonne Parish School Board appeal a trial court judgment that awarded \$10,000.00 in general damages to the plaintiff-appellee, Rosa Jones, as tutrix on behalf of her minor sister, Joyce M. Simmons, for personal injuries sustained in a school bus accident. On appeal, appellants challenge the quantum of general damages awarded. The record reveals that Joyce sustained soft-tissue issues to her neck and shoulder that required treatment for a period of approximately two months. Based on our thorough review of the record, we cannot say that the trial court abused its vast discretion in the amount of general damages awarded. <u>See</u> La. C.C. art. 2324.1; *Youn v. Maritime Overseas Corp.*, 623 So.2d 1257, 1261 (La. 1993), *cert. denied*, 510 U.S. 1114, 114 S.Ct. 1059, 127 L.Ed.2d 379 (1994). Accordingly, the trial court's judgment is affirmed in compliance with Uniform Rules – Courts of Appeal, Rule 2-16.2.A(2), (4), (6), (7), and (8). Appeal costs are assessed against defendants-appellants in the amount of \$1,123.50.

AFFIRMED.

¹ Keith Simmons, Joyce's father, originally filed this suit, individually and on behalf of Joyce. Following his death in 2010, Joyce's sister, Rosa Jones, was named as her tutrix and was substituted as Joyce's legal representative in the present matter.
